## ALLOTMENT RULES

## Allotment owners will be expected to:

- Return all tools to the tool storage area, in a clean (as possible) state after usage
- Keep the tool storage area locked, (please only share the key safe number with other allotment holders)
- Keep the planter clean and tidy, and free from weeds
- Please grow only plants, flowers, vegetables, fruits and herbs
- Keep the plot in a good state of fertility and cultivation
- Cultivate in a way that does not interfere with the enjoyment of neighbouring plot holders
- Do not grow any illegal substances, or dangerous plants such as Japanese Knotweed
- Dispose of compost waste in the designated compost area (Lockside Allotment compost area)
- Do not burn any waste (please see above for where to dispose of waste)
- Please compost kitchen scraps/waste food at home then bring rotted down compost to the planters. This is because scraps provide an excellent food source for vermin which we want to avoid at all costs and to reduce health and safety risks to Allotment users.

## Allotment owners are encouraged to:

- Swap/share seeds and plant-lings
- Share knowledge and advice
- Speak with your neighbours-you will make new friends and perhaps find someone to look after/water your plot if you are planning annual leave!
- Swap/share your produce, your favour might be returned!
- Feedback to the Allotment MS Team (Feelgood Gardening Gang) any ideas for improvements, special requests, meet up's, talks etc
