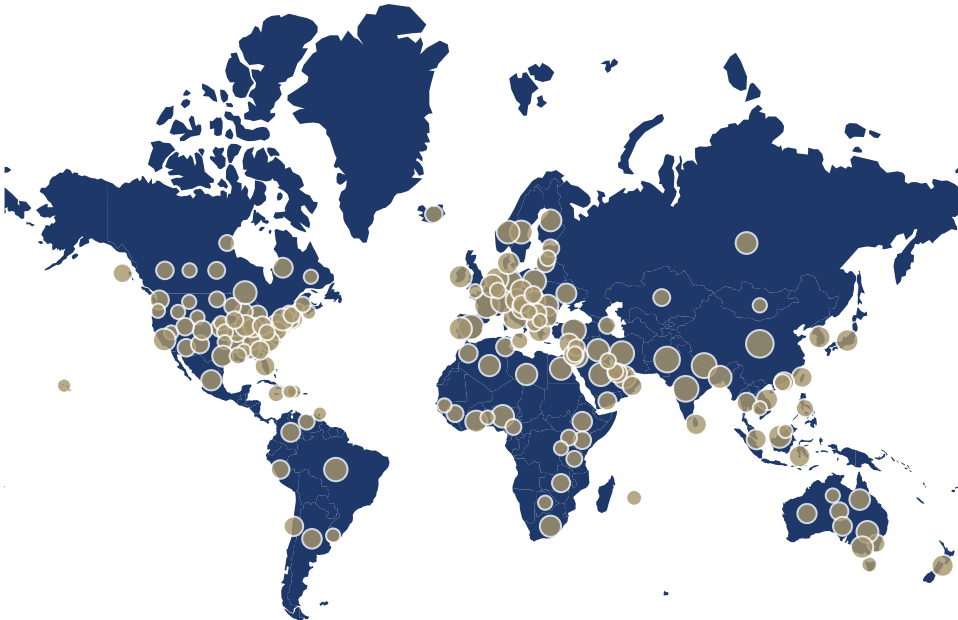

## Five ways we're changing the world

Our many research centres and institutes have been created to address the global challenges facing society today and in the future.



### Improving wound care and preventing infection

Research carried out by the Skin Interface Sciences research group has helped to shape policy and practice in the field of surgical site infection (SSI) and wound management.



### Railway research

The Institute of Railway Research is an internationally recognised centre of excellence in the field of the interaction between railway vehicles and track. This has resulted in improved understanding of the wheel rail contact and led to the development of a number of tools and techniques which are being used to predict deterioration of railway wheels and rails.

### Future Telecoms Global Network

Prof. Lazaridis from the University is building a global network of top-ranking academics that work together to generate highly impactful research in the development of next generation telecommunications 5G/6G and antennas.



### New thermal methods for materials processing

This research has improved thermal analytical techniques and made available new information on the structure and function relationships in solid-state systems. The techniques developed have been used in the characterisation of catalytic materials and pyrotechnic materials, resulting in benefits to users and manufacturers, including global companies and the defence industry.

### Designing out crime

Research undertaken by the Applied Criminology Centre (ACC) has made a significant contribution to crime prevention through environmental design. This research into 'designing out' crime has been incorporated into national and local planning policy and procedures and has influenced international urban planning.

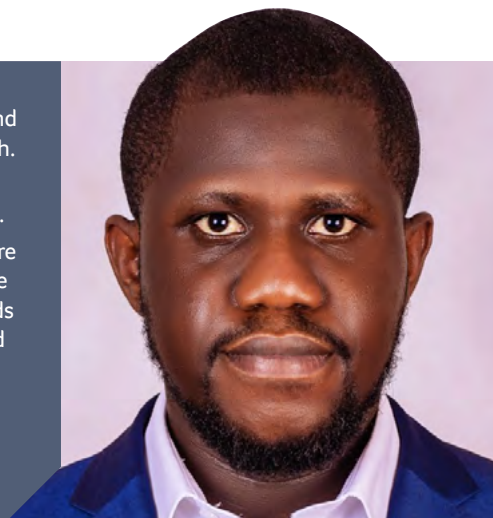

# Applying to Huddersfield

Starting your application to study in the UK is an exciting step. You can apply to the University directly, through a partner agent or through our regional offices.

See our website for details of what you will need alongside your application, the English language requirements, interviews and ATAS clearances, as well as a step-by-step guide to making your application.

## Applying for an undergraduate and postgraduate taught degree

### Apply

Apply directly, through an Agent or with help from our regional offices. Check the entry requirements for the course you want to apply to and explore options for start dates.

### Application portal

You'll receive a confirmation when we have your application with your account details for MyHud, your applicant portal, where you'll be able to track the progress of your application. You'll be provided with a unique applicant identification number.

### Your offer

If you meet the academic entry requirements for the course, and any visa eligibility checks, you will be made a conditional offer. We'll outline the conditions and deadlines you need to meet in your offer letter. If you apply through an agent, they will also be informed of your offer and can support you through the process and deadlines to meeting your conditions.

### Accept your offer

If you're ready to proceed, you can accept your offer on MyHud.

### Your Confirmation of Acceptance (CAS)

When you've completed all your offer conditions and paid your deposit, you will be emailed to confirm your details. Once confirmed, we will issue you a CAS.

### Visa application

Once you have your CAS, you can apply for your Visa. Applying early ensures you have plenty of time to await the decision, make travel arrangements, and arrive on campus in time for your studies.

## Applying for a postgraduate research degree

Applications for research degrees can be made throughout the year, normally to commence in **January, April or October**.

### Confirming your choices

Once you have a clear idea of the research degree you'd like to apply for, you can plan your application.

To apply, please complete a research degree online application form. Typically, you'll be required to submit a research proposal alongside your application, unless you are applying for a funded project. Ensure you check the deadline dates on the course page before applying.

### Up to £12,000 in scholarships

Scholarships can be a big help when considering whether to study in the UK.

We offer a merit-based scholarship programme of between £2,000 and £4,000 a year for international students. This scholarship will be awarded to eligible international applicants who apply by the application deadline for each intake\*.

The UK Government requires that international students have any outstanding first year course tuition fees plus a fixed amount for living costs. This is currently £10,224\*\*.

## Culture

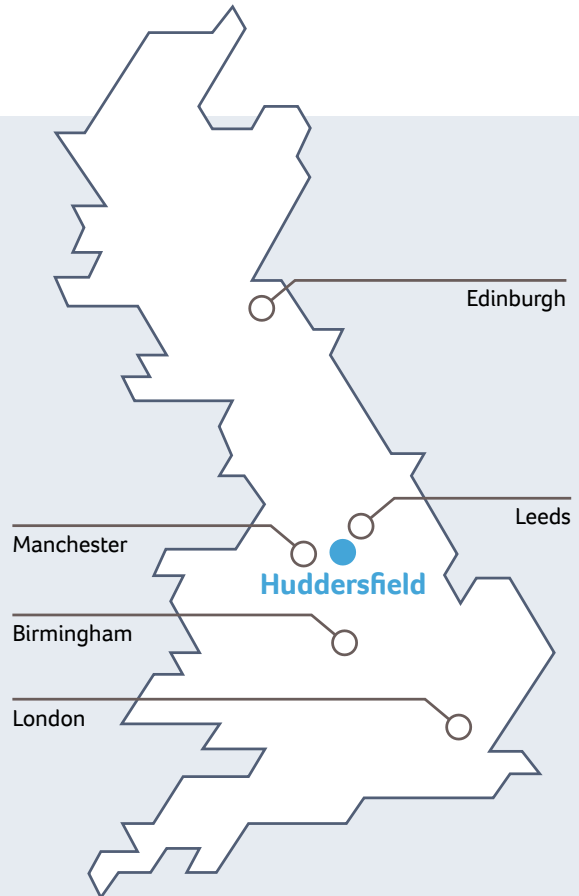

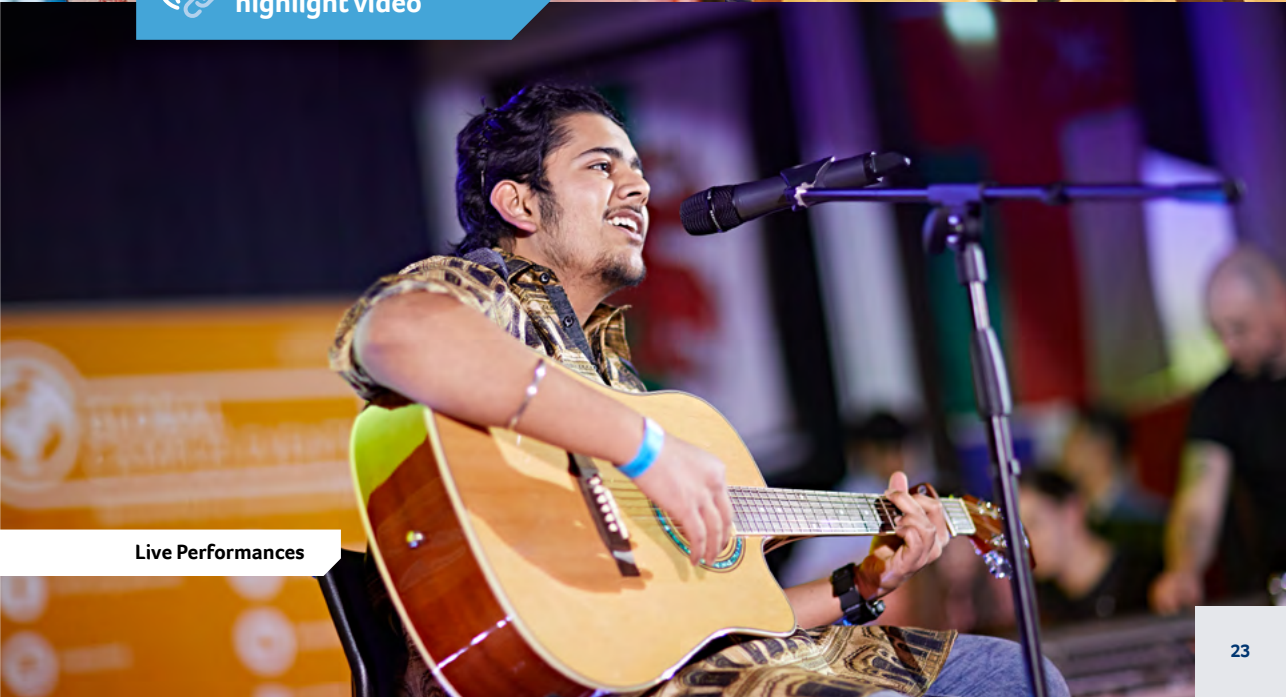

# Your study options

At Huddersfield, we put high quality teaching at the heart of what we do. We offer a range of study options including undergraduate courses, postgraduate taught courses and postgraduate research degrees.

## Undergraduate courses

### Bachelor's degree

Our full-time Bachelor's degrees normally take three years. Lots of our degrees also give you the option to take a placement or 'sandwich' year to build up your work experience, taking your degree to four years in total.

### Top-up

If you've already got a Foundation degree or a qualification like a HND, then a Top-up course gives you the chance to build on that and study for a full Honours level degree. It takes one year full-time and it is subject to you meeting the entry criteria.

### Integrated Master's degree

An integrated Master's degree gives you the opportunity to combine some undergraduate degrees with postgraduate study. Courses last four years, or five years if you spend a year on a placement. The first two years are normally the same as the equivalent Bachelor's course. At the end of the course, you'll earn a Master's level degree.

## Postgraduate taught courses

### Taught degrees

On a taught postgraduate degree, you'll learn through a combination of lectures, seminars and practical work. Courses usually contain a taught element as well as a supervised dissertation or research project.

### Master's courses with a placement

# Pathway programmes

If you do not meet the requirements for entry on to the undergraduate or postgraduate degrees at the University of Huddersfield, there are a number of pathway course options you can study to prepare you for your next step.

## Programmes with the International Study Centre

If you do not currently meet the University's direct entry requirements, it's possible to study for a preparation course through the University's partner, Study Group. Study Group offer a range of courses through the International Study Centre (ISC), located on the University of Huddersfield campus and with full access to all University facilities. At the International Study Centre, you will experience university-style teaching and develop your academic knowledge, your English language level and your employability skills.

When you successfully complete your preparation programme and achieve the required grades, you will progress on to your chosen degree course at the University of Huddersfield, without having to apply again\*.

### International Foundation Year

The International Foundation Year provides a direct path to study an undergraduate degree at the University of Huddersfield.

There are five routes available:

### International Year One

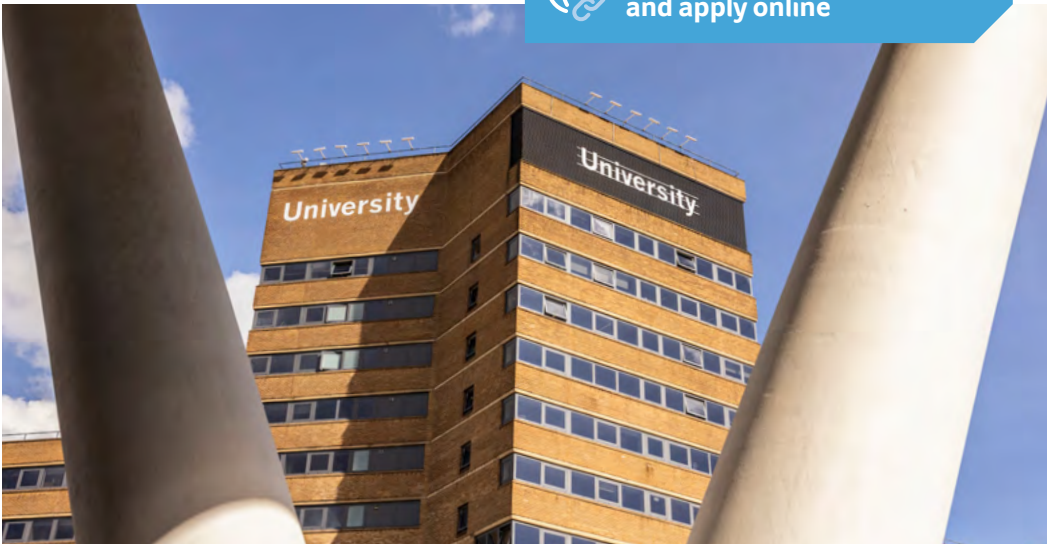
