Applying through UCAS / 15 - 30 mins

Suitable for Level 3/Year 12 and 13 audience. Students will understand the process of applying through UCAS and understand what information Admissions Tutors are looking for. This session contributes to GB1 and GB7 Gatsby Benchmarks.

Campus Tour / 45 - 60 mins

Interview Skills

Online or Face-to-face

Suitable for Level 3/Year 12/Year 13 audience. Students will be able to examine skills, knowledge and competencies needed for selection interviews. Students will also look at a range of questions which they might be faced with at interview, and have the opportunity to prepare and practice answering interview questions.

Discover Programme / 30 - 60 mins

Online or Face-to-face

Session suitable for Level3/Year 12-13/Adult Learners. Students will be able to enhance their subject knowledge and complement their studies, explore related subject areas and themes, discuss subject related topics, issues and themes with a subject specialist/expert and explore progression to Higher Education.

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Personal Statements / 30 - 60 mins

Online or Face-to-face

Suitable for Level 3/Year 12 and 13/Adults. Students will be able to understand the process of applying through UCAS. They will also identify key strengths, skills and experiences to include in a personal statement to support their course choices and enable them to gain the place they want.

Student Experience Panel / 15 - 30 mins

Online or Face-to-face

Suitable for year 11-13 audiences. This session provides an opportunity for your learners to quiz our ambassadors about all aspects of student life.
