## How much does it cost?

- Tuition Fees: up to £9,250
- Living costs: average £826.25 per month\*

\*NatWest Student Living Index July 2019: The cost of living at UK Universities



## How to pay for it?

**Tuition fee loan:** to cover the costs of fees, paid directly to the university of study

**Maintenance Loan:** to cover day to day living costs, paid directly to the student in three instalments. Use the Student Finance Calculator to estimate loan entitlement

## When do I pay it back?

Repay 9% on earnings over £27,295

**Example:** earn £30,000 – repay £20 per month

Outstanding balance cancelled after 30 years
